<u>California Senior Legislature (CSL):</u> Most of CSL's bills are in appropriations suspense file, no additional updates.

San Francisco is working through 31 budget add-backs and Mayoral projects, \$6.3million and \$6.9million for the next two years, respectively. Funding includes affordable residential care for the elderly pilot, housing, funding towards the digital divide, to meet increased nutritional needs, and more. This is in addition to Dignity Fund funding as well as State funding.
